<p>Summary of Content: This book with CD, geared towards the faux beginner or intermediate students, is designed to introduce or summarize most common expressions needed to handle everyday life situations. The content is divided into 11 chapters on various themes. Each chapter starts with a vocabulary section introducing basic sentences for various situations; the vocabulary is then re-introduced in context in the section “Dialogues” which contains the scripts of recorded dialogues (marked with a disc icon) and the text of non-recorded dialogues for additional practice. While some of the sentences in the vocabulary section are basic, the dialogues are more suited to students at the intermediate level. A French-German-English-Spanish-Japanese index is provided at the end of the book.</p>
