<p>Summary of Content: <u>Bien-dire</u> is a 52-page magazine published in France six times a year. Each issue contains short articles on a variety of topics related to France and French culture, and includes a language section which focuses on idiomatic expressions, slang, and other current, relevant vocabulary. Each article is rated according to difficulty (ranging from low-intermediate to advanced), and includes a glossary list and translated keywords. The audio CD includes an hour of select articles read by native speakers, plus pronunciation exercises. A new section “Conversations” (designed to help learners sharpen their listening skills) contains dialogs not transcribed in the magazine. This magazine is suitable for low-intermediate to advanced French learners.</p>
