<p>Summary of Content: This textbook with three CDs is geared towards students with little knowledge of French. It corresponds to level 1 of the series: <i>Phonétique Progressive du Français</i>. It consists of 56 lessons written entirely in French. The content is divided into three parts: part 1 focuses on the characteristics of the French language, part 2 on specific French sounds, and part 3 on the main difficulties of French pronunciation. The content for each lesson is introduced in French via examples and with a wide variety of recorded exercises. The method is thorough and the level of difficulty increases gradually. Students who are complete beginners may not understand the vocabulary contained in the lessons as no translation is provided. This method, especially useful to learners who have completed at least a level 1 course, exposes students to the major characteristics of French pronunciation. Answer keys of the exercises and transcripts of the CDs are contained in a separate “corrigés” inside the resource.</p>	
<p>Level: Basic User (level 1, 2): A1+, A2</p>	

Public: FLE learners, adults and young adults with little knowledge of French.

Teaching suggestions: Most appropriate for learners who have completed at least a level 1 course. Appropriate for the individual learner at home or as supplemental material for the Phonetic class. Particularly suited for home use as the method moves at a slow pace.
