<p>Summary of Content: This text written entirely in French is widely used in Phonetics courses at the faux beginner or intermediate levels. The format is structured and the content is thorough. The first part consists of 33 lessons describing the characteristics of French pronunciation and articulation. The second part focuses on rhythm and intonation in 10 lessons. The content for each lesson is introduced with a definition of the particular point to study and brief practical tips, followed by a variety of application exercises to be practiced orally with the CDs. While the vocabulary in the exercises may be challenging for beginner students, they may still improve their pronunciation and phonetic practice even though the meaning of the sentences remains uncertain.</p>
