The program starts with an introductory section called “Boîte à outils” which introduces the basics of French phonetics, including the “Alphabet Phonétique du Français” (API), the various accents, the rules of the liaisons, the silent E, the rules of pronunciation for final letters, the rules of French intonation, rhythm and syllables. The next 2 sections consist of listening practices on French sounds and intonations. Answer keys for the exercises are provided at the end of the book. The audio program can be used by beginner students as long as they do not mind not being able to understand the vocabulary in the exercises. The textbook is more appropriate for faux-beginners and up.</p>
