Summary of Content: This updated “Nouveau Petit Robert” French dictionary explains the “life of words” by focusing, in the definitions, on three areas: (1) the etymology of the French word (its history, including the date it first appeared, its origin and the evolution of its different meanings); (2) the way the word is used (spelling, pronunciation, different meanings with several examples containing appropriated locutions and expressions); and (3) the current spoken and written usage(s). Certain new words are introduced in this edition. This dictionary gives learners the opportunity to discover many related words, synonyms and antonyms. Students can explore the words of the French-speaking world through quotations from literary masterpieces, classic or contemporary authors and extracts of famous movies and songs.
