The grammar content is based on the CECR (“Cadre Européen Commun de Référence”) language standards for A2 (Basic User, level 2) and is geared towards learners who already have mastered basic grammar at level 1 (A1). The concise grammatical lessons and reviews are well complemented by ample exercises and self-evaluations on language skills of increasing difficulties. The format of the workbook is similar to the level 1 volume with the content divided into 5 units: « Le groupe nominal, le groupe verbal, les mots invariables, la phrase, Exprimez ». This practical guide is a good supplement to the material covered in intermediate-level classes. The use of English, rather than French, for the instructions makes this resource easy to use and particularly accessible to the self-taught student.</p>
