Summary of Content: This multi-level audio program in three levels (beginner, intermediate/advanced) uses conversations with French people to help the listeners understand the French. Each of the nine lessons contains a conversation with a French-speaking native. CD1 for beginners offers an introductory lesson which focuses on French sounds with an introduction of the alphabet and the numbers. The focus of the method is on listening. There are no grammar exercises. The vocabulary in some of the dialogues may not be known to the FLE learners. The accompanying booklet contains the scripts with an English translation.

Public: FLE learners, Adults with solid background in French

Teaching suggestions: The conversations could be used as listening comprehension practices for the intermediate or advanced students and could supplement lessons in Connexions 3.
