English translation of the French terms and vocabulary and grammar explanations in English are also provided. The sections “Audio Practice” and “Audio Exercise” allow students to practice their listening and speaking skills. Grammar and vocabulary exercises to be done in writing are also provided. The book also contains brief explanations on common pitfalls and cultural differences. Answer keys to the exercises, a grammar summary and French-English and English-French indexes are also provided at the end of the book. CD1 and CD2 contain the dialogues and audio exercises while CD3 contains review exercises and a summary of what has been learned.</p>
