Summary of Content: This audio program for beginners features a series of essential keywords and phrases organized around themes. The 3 CDs are organized around 8 topics: CD1 focuses on Meeting people, Eating and drinking, and Going out; CD2 on Going shopping, Around the house and Getting around; CD3 on Talking about people and Talking about the past. The vocabulary is first introduced in French. Brief explanations on vocabulary and grammar are provided in English. The program also includes audio language games for test and review. The listening guide provides bilingual lists of new vocabulary with brief grammar explanations for each lesson.

Level: Basic User (level 1): A1

Public: FLE learners, Adults with no prior knowledge of French.

Teaching suggestions: Could be used by the individual students to reinforce the materials learned in a beginner course, appropriate as a supplement to Connexions 1.
