The book is divided in 6 units, each focused on a distinct theme (from the arrival of a client to the departure). Each unit is in turn divided in six lessons with each specific language learning and grammar goals based on situations of interaction, with vocabulary and grammatical notes and exercises. Most lessons contain comprehension exercises (often dialogues) based on recorded texts and dialogs on a CD whose transcriptions are included at the end of the book. This is a specialized book for learners of French that provides a detailed linguistic approach to the business of food and accommodation services, with a lot of practical vocabulary and a wide range of practical situations and exercises. The book also contains a Grammar section and good thematic lexicons (for Hotel, Restaurant, and Wine). Transcriptions of the recorded texts and dialogues and answer keys are provided at the end of the book. The <u>pedagogical guide</u> provides teaching recommendations and answer keys. An accompanying <u>exercise book</u> can also be purchased to complete the method.</p>
