**Summary of Content:** An eclectic collection of readers - fiction and non-fiction - designed to appeal to a wide range of tastes and ages. Every title has the following features: an introduction to the text and author, supportive illustrations, footnotes on each page explaining the more difficult vocabulary. Each book ends with a thematic glossary together with some learning activities (level 1) or comprehension questions on the text itself (level 2 to 4). According to the level of difficulty, the books are of different length: level 1, 400 to 700 words; level 2, 700 to 1200 words; level 3, 1200 to 1700 words; level 4, more than 1700 words. Some titles are accompanied by an audio-cassette or CD, providing further help in listening and pronunciation, particularly for near-beginners.

**Level(s):** The 4 levels in this series correspond to the following CEFR levels:

Level 1 to CEFR level A2 (Basic User, level 2),

Level 2 to CEFR level A2+ (Basic User, level 2),

Level 3 to CEFR level B1 (Independent User, level 1),

Level 4 to CEFR level B2 (Independent User, level 2)
